## **Audio and Signal Management – Ear Monitor and Mics**

The band uses a Midas XR18 Air digital mixer to independently manage all audio signals, including in-ear monitors and full instrument miking, drums included.

All microphones are to be provided by the venue. Microphones and XLR cables are required.

#### A) When a sound engineer is present:

All channels can be split via a 2-way splitter owned by the band (8+8 = 16 channels), allowing the sound engineer to manage front-of-house volumes independently.

Alternatively, the sound engineer can connect directly to our mixer via Wi-Fi, using a tablet or PC with the Mixing-Station app, available for both Android and Apple devices.

#### B) When no sound engineer is present:

The band is fully autonomous in managing front-of-house volumes. In this case, it will be sufficient to connect the L+R outputs of our mixer directly to the venue's PA system.



### **Technical and Logistical Requirements – Backstage and Stage**

### **Backstage - Minimum requirements:**

- · 220V power outlets
- 5 bottles of still water
- 5 Red Bulls
- A mirror

### Before the performance – To be prepared on stage:

- 2 bottles of room-temperature still water for each band member
- 3 bottles of room-temperature still water for the singer

#### Meals:

- 5 meals + 1 for the sound engineer (if present). Alternatively, a fair buyout per person can be provided upon arrival at the venue.
- One team member is allergic to nuts and buffalo mozzarella.
- Another member is allergic to eggs.

### **Dressing room:**

The availability of a dressing room or private area to change clothes and store personal belongings is appreciated.
